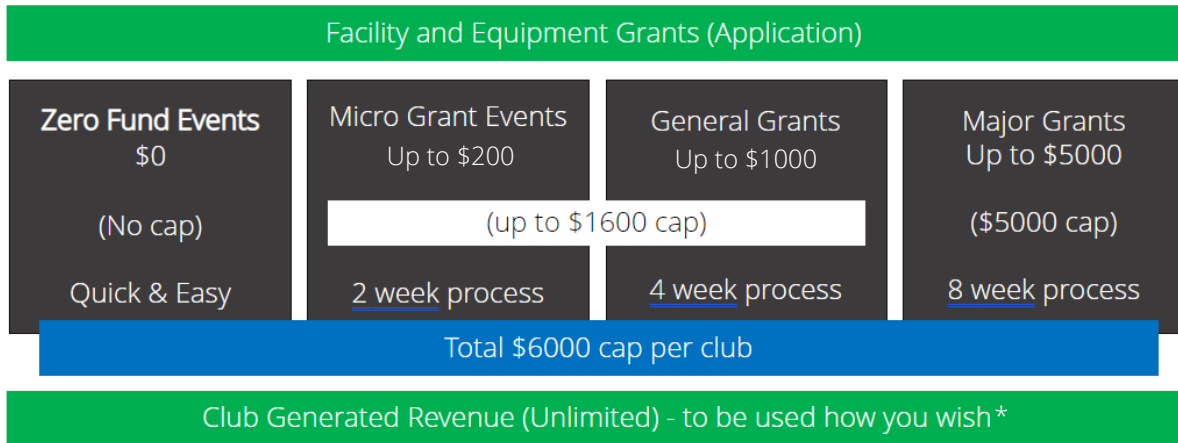


## Clubs & Sport 2024 Funding Model

### Funding categories

Club accounts will be reflective of revenue, and you will apply for funds based on the event you're running, or equipment/facilities you need.



### Types of events funding available, processing time and conditions

Type of events	FUNDING CATEGORIES			
	No-fund	Micro-grant	General-grant	Major-grant
Cap	n/a	\$1600 combined		Up to \$5000
Processing time <i>(out from event date)</i>	1 week	2 weeks	4 weeks	8 weeks

- **No-fund:** Events that don't require funds, such as weekly/monthly catch up.
- **Micro-grant:** Small-scale events with only minor equipment needs such as an on-campus barbeque or a Clubs Day stall.
- **General-grant:** Standard events such as video game tournaments, or workshops.
- **Major-grant:** special events such as industry nights, cultural celebrations and festivals.

### Facilities & equipment grants

- For equipment and facilities you **NEED** to run your club, like sports facilities or servers.
- Funding is judged on case-by-case basis.
- Submit a budget twice a year, at the beginning of each semester.
- Approximately 8-week processing period.

### Club generated revenue \*

- Revenue you generate outside of club funding.
- Can be invested in club resources, carried to the next year or used for activities not covered by grants.
- Unlimited number of revenue streams and more flexible to spend.
- Must be requested via ENF's or Funds Request Forms.
- Still requires approval from C&S and payment must be made through accepted methods.
- Clubs & Sport, and Swinburne policies apply to club revenue regarding acceptable expenses.
