

When should I submit my event?

Time in weeks

Event type	Publish ENF	Grant request form	
No funds	1	n/a	
Micro \$0-\$200	2	n/a	
General \$201 -\$1000	4	n/a	
Major \$1001 - \$5000	12	8	

Via ENF

Don't forget: Clubs must run two events (Micro and/or general) to be eligible for a Major Grant








On-campus event spaces

Policy essentials

Clubs need to run minimum 2 events (approved on UniOne) each semester to stay registered Unapproved events are NOT official club events (Cannot use club name, club logo, promote on socials)

Tickets can only be sold using **C&S** software

Do not buy anything without C&S approval.
